Supply List

Sewing machine and equipment:

- sewing machine with bobbins, electrical cords, foot pedal
- quarter-inch sewing machine foot
- walking foot (optional)
- · machine manual
- electrical power strip and heavy duty extension cord

Sewing tools:

- extra machine needles
- · straight pins
- seam ripper
- fabric scissors and small trimming scissors
- scissors for cutting paper
- thread medium value to coordinate with project, or beige or gray
- extra bobbins
- coordinating thread and invisible thread for machine quilting (if time permits)

Rotary cutting and Ironing Equipment:

- rotary cutter with new blade
- cutting mat
- ruler
- mini-iron and ironing mat for ironing at your table (optional there will be two regular sized ironing stations available))

Miscellaneous:

- several zip-lock bags for small fabric pieces
- camera (optional)

Fabric:


The following page lists minimum requirements. It is a good idea to bring more fabric than you need to give yourself more choices. You may also choose to make a larger quilt (baby, lap, etc). If you choose to make a scrappy quilt, then bring lots of scraps that can be cut into $1\frac{1}{2}$ to 2 inch strips.

For Project 1 Table Runner you will need:

- ¹/₄ yd each of 3 dark coordinating fabrics
- ¹/₄ yd each of 3 light coordinating fabrics
- ¹/₄ yd red fabric (or other color of your choice)
- ¹/₄ yd light fabric for inner border
- 1 yd for outer border and binding

To finish each quilt you will need:

- 28" x 44" piece of batting (thin, lowloft)
- 28" x 44" fabric for backing




Finished size: 24 1/2" x40 1/2"


For Project 2 Table Runner (apples or pumpkins) you will need:

- 1/4 yd of red, green and yellow fabrics, or orange fabrics
- ¹/₄ yd of light background fabrics
- fabric images to fussy cut for the pumpkins (optional)
- 1/4 yd for inner border
- 1 yd for outer border and binding

To finish each quilt you will need:

- 21" x 34" piece of batting (thin, lowloft)
- 21" x 34" fabric for backing





Finished size: 17"x30"

For Project 3 Wreath Wall Hanging you will need:

- 1 yd of assorted green or green holiday fabrics
- 1/4 1/2 yd of light background fabrics
- small piece of red, small piece of yellow
- 1/4 yd for inner border
- 1 yd for outer border and binding

To finish each quilt you will need:

- 32" x 32" piece of batting (thin, lowloft)
- 32" x 32" fabric for backing



Finished size: 28"x28"
